HB 4705 (Rep. Meerman)

A bill to amend 1976 PA 267, entitled "Open meetings act," (MCL 15.261 to 15.275) by adding section 9a.

Bree Anderson and Jack Harris, representing the Michigan Department of Technology Management and Budget, testified in opposition to HB 4705. Questions and discussion followed.

Representative Meerman, testified in support of HB 4705. Questions and discussion followed.

Representative Hoitenga moved to adopt substitute (H-1) to HB 4705. The motion prevailed 9-0-0:

| SB 508 | (Sen. Johnson) | A bill to amend 2008 PA 23, entitled "Enhanced driver license and enhanced official state personal identification card act," by amending sections 4 and 6 (MCL 28.304 and 28.306), section 4 as amended by 2020 PA 305 and section 6 as amended by 2020 PA 374. |
| SB 509 | (Sen. VanderWall) | A bill to amend 1972 PA 222, entitled "An act to provide for an official personal identification card; to provide for its form, issuance and use; to regulate the use and disclosure of information obtained from the card; to prescribe the powers and duties of the secretary of state; to prescribe fees; to prescribe certain penalties for violations; and to provide an appropriation for certain purposes," by amending section 2 (MCL 28.292), as amended by 2020 PA 306. |
