COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

The House Committee on Regulatory Reform was called to order by the Chair.

The Chair laid HB 4711 before the committee:

HB 4711 (Rep. Hall)

A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled "Michigan liquor control code of 1998," by amending section 513 (MCL 436.1513), as amended by 2020 PA 121.

Representative Hall testified in support of HB 4711. Questions and discussion followed.

Shaun Willis and Sam Gilbertson, representing the Northwoods League, testified in support of HB 4711. Questions and discussion followed.
