BACKGROUND & SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES SUBMITTED TO JCAR

The proposed rule change would update the rules for the Youth Employment Standards to align them with statutory changes made under PA 197 of 2011 (HB 4732). For a complete summary of the enacting legislation, see the House Fiscal Agency analysis¹. The proposed rule change would update the language of R 408.6302 (2) (f) (ii) and (iii) to align with PA 197 of 2011, which decoupled a combined school and work week of up to 48 hours and replaced it with a work week not exceeding 24 hours a week if the minor is a student in school and school is in session.

FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED RULES

The proposed rules would have no fiscal impact on the State or local units of government.
