# AGRICULTURAL WORKER OVERVIEW

- **Three Types of Ag Workers:**
  - 1. Migrant - >75 Miles**
  - 2. Seasonal – Work Near Home**
  - 3. Year-Round – Dairy & Food Processing**
- **Michigan has the seventh highest Ag Worker Population**

# 2013 AG WORKER STUDY

- 94,167 migrant and seasonal workers and dependents
- 61,564 migrants and dependents
- 27,965 migrant children ages 0-19

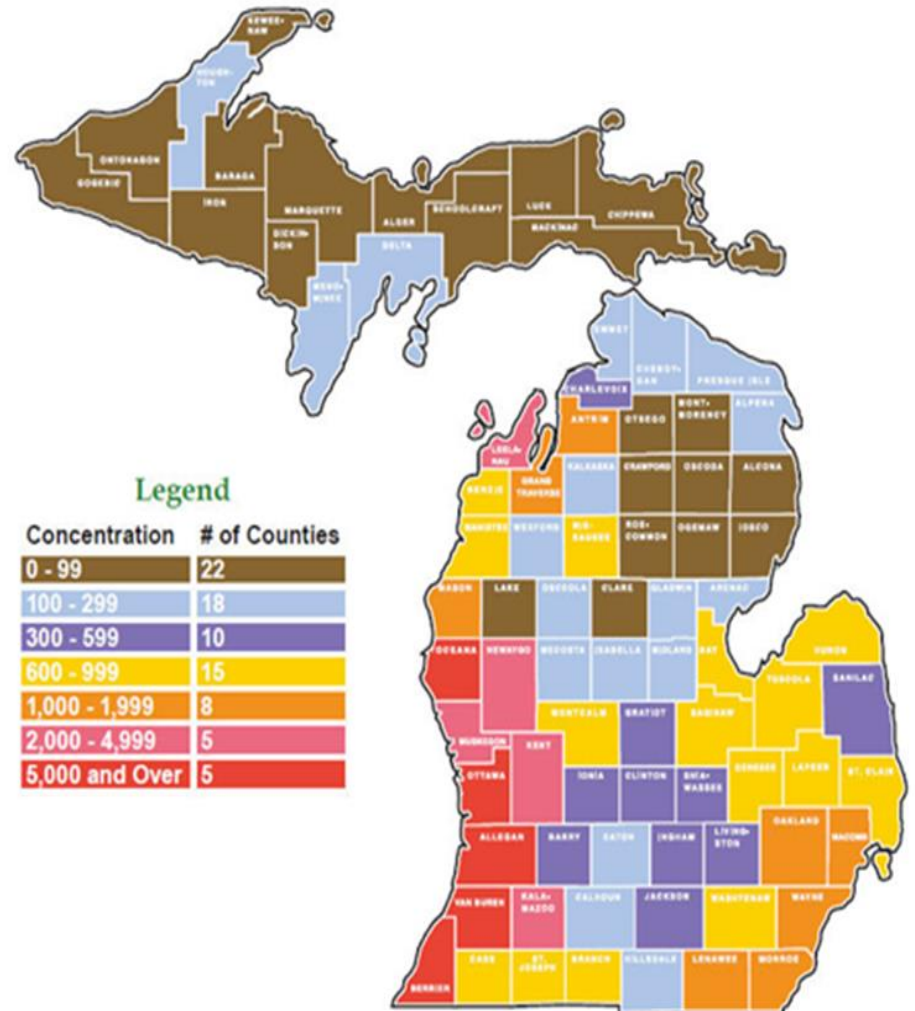
# 2013 AG WORKER STUDY
