This transfer moves \$1,006,100 of GF/GP funds from the Worker's Compensation Program line item to the Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Program line item. The FY 2013-14 enacted budget includes an increase of state restricted funds authorization of the same amount from proposed emergency medical services licensure fee increases that will not be realized as the necessary amendments for the fee changes have not been enacted in statute. This transfer will resolve the funding shortfall for FY 2013-14 by providing GF/GP funds to support the planned EMS program budget, sustaining licensing and regulation functions required under the Public Health Code. The Executive indicates that this transfer is needed by February 1, 2014.

Sufficient GF/GP funds are available from the Worker's Compensation Program line item for this transfer as the line item authorization exceeds anticipated expenditures for worker's compensation claims in the Department.
