## **BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES**

Rule Set 2019-110 LR would rescind numerous rules promulgated under the authority of the Electrical Administrative Act, 1956 PA 217, an act which has subsequently been repealed and replaced by the Skilled Trades Regulation Act, 2016 PA 407. The rescissions within the rule set would allow the Bureau of Construction Codes to remove outdated language that was promulgated under the Electrical Administrative Act, so that a new rule set can be promulgated to reflect regulation under the Skilled Trades Regulation Act.

## **FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED RULES**

2019-110 LR is not anticipated to affect the expenditures or revenues of any state or local government units.
