BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

Rule Set 2020-95 LR would rescind the Electric Interconnection and Net Metering Standards rule set, which would be replaced by rules being concurrently promulgated in rule set 2020-96 LR. The rule sets pertain to how projects owned by customers, developers, and utilities connect to the utility distribution system. The changes contained in 2020-95 LR and 2020-96 LR are being pursued to implement necessary updates, due to rapid advances in distributed energy resource technology and increased distributed generation.

FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED RULES

2020-95 LR would not be anticipated to have a fiscal impact on any units of state or local government.
