BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

Rule Set 2019-122 LE would include amendments and rescissions to rules regarding health and safety hazards in the workplace with respect to plastic molding machines. Specifically, the set would amend rules for lockout and guarding to reflect current technologies in use in the plastics industry.
