BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

These proposed rules would allow persons with a disability to use an electric bicycle in Mackinac Island State Park and prohibit fireworks in the park. This specific allowance of an electric bicycle mirrors a similar administrative rule change adopted by the National Park Service. The prohibition of fireworks mirrors extant restrictions in the balance of Michigan's state park facilities and the constituent properties of the National Park Service.

FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED RULES

It is unlikely that the proposed rules would affect costs or revenue for DNR. These changes are also unlikely to affect costs or revenues for local units of government.
