BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

Rule Set 2020-82 LR would make numerous amendments and recissions to rules that regulate scheduling and activities with respect to controlled substances. Specifically, the rule set would adopt the federal controlled substances schedule; clarify when a controlled substances license is required; modify training and licensure requirements; clarify prescription, dispensation, and administration of a controlled substance to a drug dependent individual; clarify inventory and record retention requirements; provide requirements related to electronic prescription transmission; and modify reporting to the Michigan Automated Prescription System.

FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED RULES

2020-82 LR is not anticipated to have a fiscal impact on the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs or on any other state or local government units.
