BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

Rule Set 2020-29 LR would make numerous additions and amendments to rules pertaining to the pharmacy technician profession. Specifically, the rule set would: clarify the application process and requirements to obtain a pharmacy technician license; require accreditation of Board-approved pharmacy technician programs; include a rule regarding temporary licensure; require pharmacy technician programs be reviewed every 5 years; require that relicensure applicants show good moral character, submit to fingerprinting, and complete human trafficking training; modify continuing education requirements; and modify the delegated activities pharmacy technicians could perform.

FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED RULES

2020-29 LR is not anticipated to have fiscal impact on any units of state or local government.
