BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

These proposed changes to the state land use rules would provide exemptions to leash requirements for dogs or other animals in a designated day use areas on land under the control of the department other than state parks, recreation areas, game and wildlife areas, designated campgrounds, and public access sites.

FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED RULES

It is unlikely that the proposed rules would affect costs or revenue for DNR. These changes are also unlikely to affect costs or revenues for local units of government.
