BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES

Rule Set 2019-108 LR would make numerous additions, amendments, and rescissions to rules pertaining to the licensure of veterinarians. The rule set would provide definitions, establish a rule for telehealth, identify the approved examination and educational programs for licensure, revise and clarify requirements for licensure and relicensure, establish new rules for a senior student limited license and a graduate of a nonapproved veterinary education program limited license, clarify supervision and delegation rules, revise requirements for medical records retention, clarify continuing education requirements, and rescind various rules for clarity and statutory authority considerations.

FISCAL IMPACT OF PROPOSED RULES

2019-108 LR is not anticipated to have a significant fiscal impact on the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs or on any other unit of state or local government.
