### **BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULES**

Rule Set 2021-57 LR would make numerous amendments to rules pertaining to the licensure of veterinarians. The rule set would clarify and revise requirements for telehealth service provision (to ensure veterinary care standards are met), update examination and accreditation standards, amend licensure and relicensure requirements, clarify delegation and supervision requirements, and revise a rule regarding animal patient medical records.
