This transfer would provide \$250.0 million in state restricted contingency authorization to the Michigan Strategic Site Readiness Program (SSRP) pursuant to Sec. 406 of 2022 PA 194, Sec. 311 of 2023 PA 1, and Sec. 702 of 2023 PA 5. Funds would be transferred into the SSRP to fund the program activities as outlined under subsections 2, 3, 4, and 5, of Sec. 408 of 2022 PA 194, which makes the following allocations:

- \$25.0 million for grants to regional and local economic development organizations or other eligible applicants which may be used for site assessments to identify the improvements and associated costs required to bring each site to a state of readiness.
- \$100.0 million for grants to eligible applicants for improvements to strategic sites without an identified end-user.
- \$75.0 million for the assessment and development of mega-strategic sites as set forth in subsection 4.
- \$50.0 million for grants to eligible applicants for improvements to strategic sites with an identified end-user.

The MSF Board approved program guidelines for the Michigan Strategic Site Readiness Program on January 11, 2022 and amended them on January 24, 2023 to conform with 2022 PA 194. Once this transfer is approved by the Legislature, the Michigan Strategic Fund Board will approve specific projects that utilize the funds within each of these four allocations.
