Michigan Wildlife Council

- ◆ Council members (appointed by Governor)
 - DNR Director (or designee)
 - 4 individuals who have purchased a Michigan hunting or fishing license
 - 1 from a hunting/fishing-related business
 - 1 from the agriculture community
 - 1 with a media or marketing background
 - 1 from a rural area with large involvement in hunting/fishing

◆ Purpose

- Educate the general public
 - Role that sportsmen and women play in conservation
 - Hunting, fishing, trapping:
 - are necessary for conservation and management of natural resources
 - are part of our culture and should be preserved
 - provide jobs and economic benefit to the state
