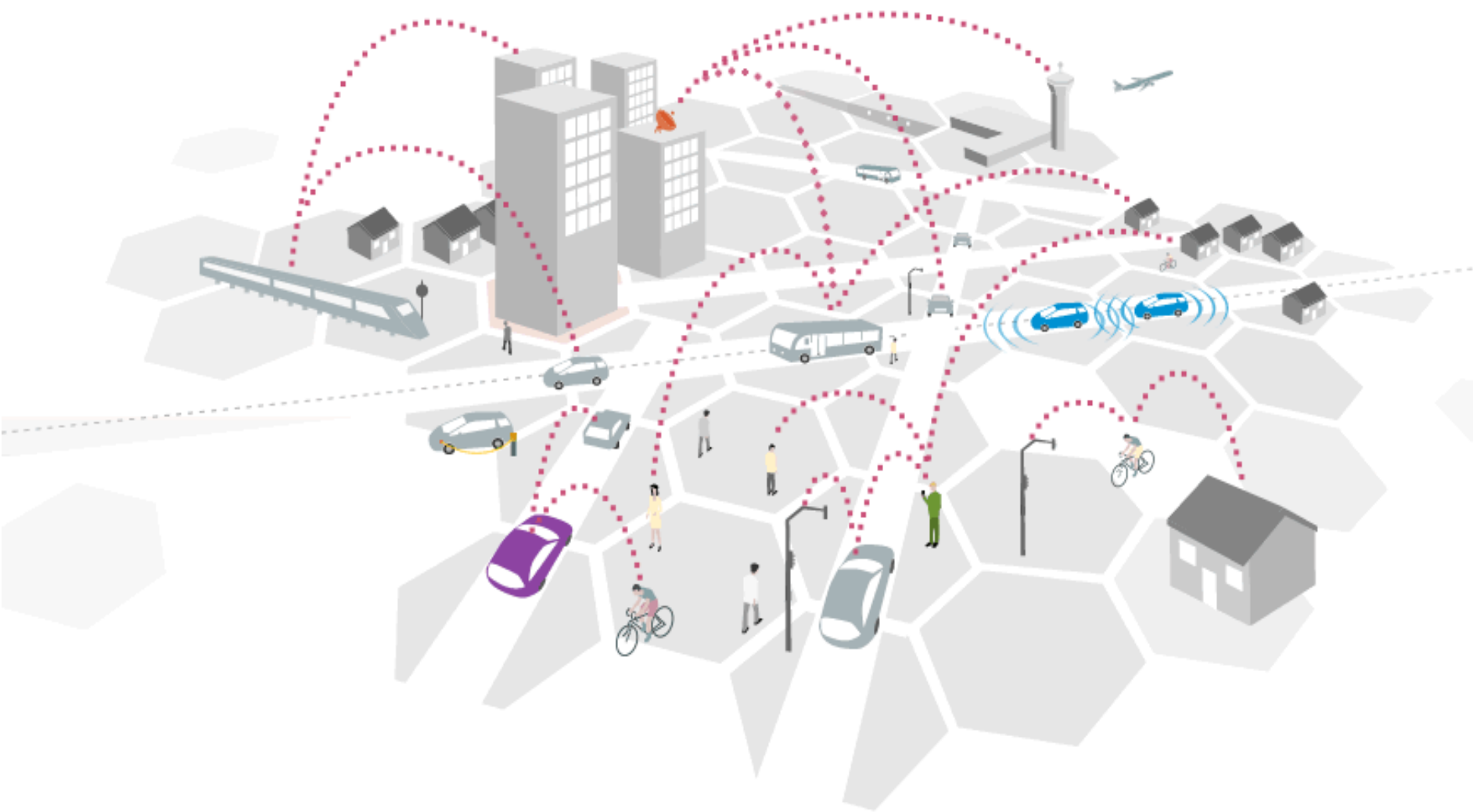

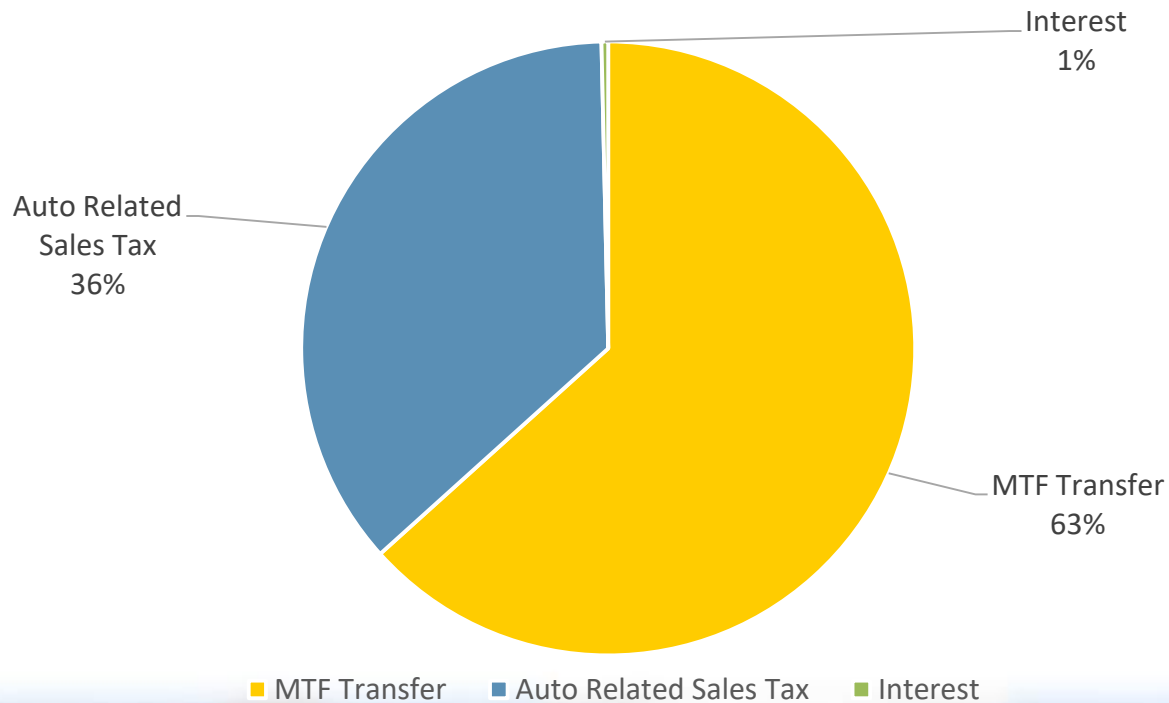


# Michigan Public Transit Facts

- 80 transit agencies provided 88M rides in 2015
- 2/3 of Michigan transit systems are rural
- Michigan transit systems saw an increase in miles of service by 3% last year
- Using the statewide average for all systems, 17% of an agency's revenue is from fare box and 51% is local investment

# Local Bus Operating History

## Eligible Operating Reimbursement

Year	Appropriation	Urban Systems	Rural Systems
2000	\$149,976,300	40.98%	49.17%
2005	\$161,680,000	33.68%	40.41%
2010	\$166,624,000	31.45%	37.74%
*2015	\$167,400,000	30.67%	36.81%
*Current	\$186,250,000	~32.40%	~38.52%

Statutory reimbursement limits are 50% for urban systems and 60% for rural systems

\*Year not reconciled or audited

# Bus Capital

- This program provides state share to match federal funds under various federal programs
- Governed by Act 51 and MDOT policy
- 35% of the states transit fleet is beyond its useful life

# The Ride in Ann Arbor

## Catering to Community

<b>The WAVE</b>	Western Washtenaw Area Value Express connects Dexter, Chelsea, and Ann Arbor
<b>People's Express</b>	Dial-a-ride service for townships in Washtenaw County and transfers to a number of bus stops on the AATA bus route.
<b>UM Busses &amp; The Ride</b>	Active students, faculty, and staff at the University of Michigan have unlimited access to TheRide's fixed route bus service through an agreement by which UM pays fares for UM riders.
<b>AirRide</b>	Comfortable, modern businesses that connect Ann Arbor to DTW
<b>Park &amp; Ride</b>	There are 6 free park & rides lots
<b>Bike Racks</b>	Busses have bike racks for ease to and from transit stations
